Directions

#1 – Acquire your assigned book (see the below list) from the public library or local bookstore. You could also order your book online (like from Amazon). You can choose to read a print or digital copy or listen to an audio version.

#2 – Begin reading your book. As you read, complete Defender Logs in print form or digitally. You can find extra copies of this handout available online at our website (<http://www.bsbs.fcps.net/>). You can complete the work on extra copies of the handout you print, on your own paper, or digitally by saving your work to your school account or a flash drive.

#3 – Make sure you complete a minimum of five (5) Defender Logs. And, choose a variety of questions to answer from the list—do not always choose the same question from the same column!

#4 – Make sure you finish reading your book and at least five (5) Defender Logs prior to the start of the school year (Wednesday, August 16, 2017).
